WRECK PHOTO WEEKs with AQUANAUTS GRENADA November 2nd to 9th and December 7th to 14th 2002

Capture the "Titanic of the Caribbean" and other spectacular wrecks for 2 weeks in November/December 2002; daily 3 tank dive, wreck night dive, island tour, beach BBQ, lots of fun + international photo contest!

Grenada, July 1. 2002: Grenada's dive sites feature besides a variety of unspoiled reefs a number of spectacular wrecks. First there is the "Titanic of the Caribbean"; the 600 foot/200 m long cruise liner "Bianca C", that sank in 1961. Then the newest addition "Shakem" – a German built cargo vessel that went down just a year ago. Other wrecks wait to be explored and captured on film by divers, such as the "King Mitch", a WW2 mine sweeper with a lot of pelagic marine life and the "SAN JUAN", a fishing vessel that is now home to about 20 nurse sharks of all sizes out in the Atlantic. These wrecks and others are a challenge for dedicated wreck photographers.

Rendezvous Beach & Dive Resort and Aquanauts will dedicate two weeks this year for the event. Planned are daily three tank dives, a wreck night dive, daily film development, photo contest with international jury, island tour, beach BBQ and much more fun.
